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«For a list of both prescription and over-the-counter drugs and contraceptive supplies that are reimbursable for pharmacy dispensing through the Family Planning, Access, Care and Treatment (Family PACT) Program, providers should refer to the *Family PACT Pharmacy Formulary* on the Medi-Cal Rx website (<https://medi-calrx.dhcs.ca.gov>) under Forms & Information.» Guidelines for pharmacy and onsite dispensing may differ for some drugs.

«Restrictions are noted throughout the *Family PACT Pharmacy Formulary*. The use of drugs outside of the specified conditions is not reimbursable.»

«For specific coverage criteria for oral contraceptives and ulipristal acetate emergency contraceptive, refer to the *Contract Drugs List* in the *Medi-Cal Rx Provider Portal* on the Medi-Cal Rx website (<https://medi-calrx.dhcs.ca.gov>). For specific coverage criteria for levonorgestrel emergency contraceptives, refer to *Contract Drugs List – Over-the-Counter Drugs* section in the *Medi-Cal Rx Provider Portal*.
